Resident Feedback Evaluation Report

On Net Communications, (ONC), have carried out a research survey by telephone with 999 residents from a database of 4000 residential contacts purchased from UK Changes Ltd. The survey was to ascertain the opinion and views of local residents with regards to the planning application for twenty six wind turbines at Kype Muir (south of Strathaven and north west of Lesmahagow).

Database Analysis Pre-Calling

The data purchased from UK Changes was for residents in the following areas:- Strathaven and Sandford 60% Stonehouse 20% Lesmahagow 20%.

Overall Call Analysis


Following Data protection legislation and the market research code of practice a total of 5710 calls were made by ONC researchers. Calls were made between the hours of 9.30am and 9.00pm and each number was called a maximum of 3 times. A breakdown of call outcomes are as follows:

- > 1957 Contacts made including completed questionnaires, residents refusing to answer questionnaires, and residents wishing to be removed from the database.
- 309 Unobtainable Contacts were recorded including telephones numbers not in service; not recognised and wrong.
- > 3444 Remaining Contacts were recorded including answering machines, call backs, voice mail and no answers.

The sample size of 999 completed surveys represents a 99% confidence level with a 4% confidence interval. 599 in Strathaven and Sandford 200 in Stonehouse and 200 in Lesmahagow




Q1) Are you aware of the planning application for twenty six wind turbines at Kype Muir, located south of Strathaven?




Q3) Are you aware that the site lies within South Lanarkshire Council's designated wind farm search area?

Q4) Are you aware that if approved a wind farm of this size would contribute around £7,000,000 into a community benefit fund over a 25 year period?






