Notice is hereby given that Banks Renewables (Harting Rig Wind Farm) Limited, a company incorporated under the Companies Acts with company number 08791006 and having its registered office at Inkerman House, St Johns Road, Durham, DH7 8XL Limited has received from Scottish Ministers a variation under section 36C of the Electricity Act 1989 ("the Act") of the consent granted under section 36 of the Act on 16th September 2016 to construct and operate the Kype Muir Wind Farm Extension at land approximately 6.5 km to the south-west of Strathaven and 4.5 km south-east of Drumclog (Central Grid Reference NS 69832, 37323). The varied development will have a generating capacity of over 50MW and be comprised of 15 turbines with a ground to blade tip height of between 156 and 220 metres.

Scottish Ministers have also directed, under Section 57 (2) of the Town & Country Planning Act (Scotland) 1997, that planning permission is deemed to be granted.
